1. All matches to consist of 50 targets each for Singles, Handicap, Doubles, and Skeet. Skeet will be shot at Vancouver, Langley, and Mission clubs **ONLY**.
2. Shooters may shoot any or all events of each match.
3. Shooters may shoot on Saturday or Sunday. Matches will be the same on both days. If any person shoots two of the same events at any club, the first score will be counted.
4. Fees will be \$15.00 CAD at Canadian clubs and \$15.00 USD at US clubs per 50 target event (\$6.00 CAD or \$6.00 USD for juniors). **Clubs may waive fee for junior shooters.**
5. \$3.00 CAD per 50 target event shot by each adult shooter will be remitted by the host club to the league for trophies and banquet. There is no trophy fee for junior shooters under the age of 17.
6. Shooters **must** shoot 5 of 6 matches to qualify for individual trophies.
7. Team trophies, except aggregate events, will be based on the top 5 shooters from each club at each match. These scores will be shown in **bold face type and underlined on the summary sheet**. All shooters must declare which club they are shooting for before the first event.
8. Only one (1) perpetual trophy may be won by any shooter.
9. Shooters will stand at their regular PITA or 1 yard less than their earned I.T.S.L yardage, whichever is greater. New shooters will stand at 20 yards (19 yards for ladies and juniors). Winners and all ties will be punched 1 yard. Second place and all ties will be punched ½ yard. These punches do **NOT** affect your PITA or ATA yardage.
10. **ALL MATCHES START AT 9:00AM SHARP (The Sunday shoot at Pitt Meadows will start at 10:00AM).** Please try to arrive as early as possible in order to help out the host club to keep things running smoothly. **Clubs reserve the right to restrict or refuse any entries after 1:00PM.**
11. The banquet will be hosted by Ridgedale Rod and Gun Club on Saturday, March 16 at 1:00PM. The 50 bird handicap shoot will start at 9:00AM SHARP prior to the banquet. Payout will be 60/40 split on Handicap. **BANQUET TICKETS WILL BE \$10 PER PERSON AND AVAILABLE AT EACH HOST CLUB. PLEASE PURCHASE YOUR TICKET EARLY TO HELP DETERMINE NUMBERS.**
